Keep Australia Beautiful (KAB) has been a leader in environmental responsibility and change since 1975. KAB runs the Eco-Schools Program, Sustainable Communities Tidy Towns Awards Program and the Keep Australia Beautiful Week and our iconic "Do The Right Thing" Campaigns.



Schools are the heart of our communities. A litter-free, healthy, eco-friendly school is a real asset to a community – as part of the physical environment of a local area and as a site where young people gain knowledge, skills and positive attitudes towards the environment. The introduction of this program gives a real boost to Keep Australia Beautiful's mission for a litter free and sustainable Australia.



### **Overall Eco-Schools Program Sponsorship**

Eco-Schools is a proven schools-based sustainability education framework operating in 74 countries globally and developed by the Foundation for Environmental Education (FEE).

It is a curriculum-linked, democratic and participatory program that provides an excellent opportunity for students to experience active citizenship in their schools. Both schools and the wider community benefit from this program.

## Eco-Schools follow 7 Steps to investigate and take action on one or more of the Eco-Schools 7 Themes.

When a school has worked through each of the 7 Steps, for at least 3 Themes, they can then apply for Eco-Schools Green Flag accreditation. The Eco-Schools Green Flag is international and recognised by organisations such as UNESCO. It is a symbol of a school's commitment to environmental education.

Eco-Schools makes working on sustainability practical and fun and is motivational for students and teachers. Environmental issues and the thought of tackling them can sometimes be overwhelming. Many of those interested in promoting education-based eco-action will wonder:

- How and where do I begin?
- How can I involve and engage young people?
- How can I retain focus and momentum?
- How can we have a positive impact on issues so numerous, overwhelming and global such as the climate crisis or marine plastic pollution???

The Eco-Schools program provides a solution to all these questions. Our Seven Step Framework has been designed as a very simple environmental management system that empowers young people to introduce and lead environmental actions and education in their school and beyond!



#### **Overall Eco-Schools Program Sponsorship**

The Seven Eco-Schools steps are designed to make environmental actions pupilled. Working through each of the seven steps and achieving Eco-Schools Green Flag accreditation can be done in a single academic year. Several of the steps, for example Step 5: Informing and Involving, naturally overlap and this is encouraged – our process is designed to be holistic.

Below is a brief summary of each step. More detailed information can be found on our website https://www.eco-schools.org.au/7-steps/

- **1.** Form an Eco-Committee, a group of students and adults responsible for all things Eco-Schools.
- 2. Complete an Environmental Review, a free-to-download resource which has been designed to review learning environments and provide inspiration to Eco-Committees.
- **3.** Create an Action Plan, a plan for environmental actions in the school.
- **4.** Link the program to the Curriculum, including environmental issues in the school.
- **5.** Informing and Involving the wider community, including all pupils, staff members and the local community in Eco-Schools work.
- 6. Monitoring and Evaluation of eco-projects, measuring the impact of the projects in the Action Plan.
- 7. Creating an Eco-Code, a rallying call that everyone can get behind!



## **Sponsor an Eco-Schools Theme**

Australian Eco-Schools can choose from seven themes to tackle with the seven step process. The Themes are designed to align with the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (UN SDGs).



#### Theme 1: Biodiversity- Habitats and Homes

Maintaining and improving the incredible variety of life on a local and global level. This theme aligns with the UN SDG's 14 and 15.





#### Theme 2: Climate & Energy- Super Smart Power

Reducing energy use and investing in greener energy sources. This Theme aligns with UN SDG 7.



## Theme 3: Fair Go- Global Citizen for Social Justice

Taking an active role in your community and making our planet more peaceful, sustainable and fair. This Theme aligns with UN SDG 10.



#### Theme 4: Lifestyles- Healthy & Active

Addressing your, and our planet's health. These two issues are intrinsically linked! This Theme aligns with UN SDG 3.

#### Theme 5: Waste- The Cycle of Stuff:

Refusing, reducing, reusing, repairing, recycling. This Theme aligns with UN SDG 12.

#### Theme 7: Water- Drink, Think, Save the Sink

Valuing and preserving our most important natural resource. This Theme aligns with UN SDG 6.

## **Sponsor Eco-Schools Teacher Training**

The Eco-Schools program is designed to be picked up easily by schools, but we do offer teacher training webinars across the year for newcomers, and as a platform for Eco-Schools Teachers to meet. The Training Schedule includes:

- October to November: Information about the program to get schools started in the new school year.
- January to March: Starting on the Eco-Schools Journey Getting an Eco-Committee together and suggested timings of projects.
- **February to March**: Steps 2 and 3 Conducting the Environmental Review and creating an Action Plan to ensure Green Flag criteria are met.
- **February to June**: Step 4 Going over effective Monitoring & Evaluation techniques to ensure Green Flag criteria are met.
- March to July: Steps 5 and 6 How to Link to the Curriculum and Inform and Involve the wider community to ensure Green Flag criteria are met.
- June to October: Tips on evaluating projects
- October to November: Advice on submitting accreditation applications (Bronze Award, Silver Award or Green Flag).
- At the start and end of every school term: Information about the program to get schools motivated to join the program

Workshops are approximately 1.5 hours, depending on discussion and questions, and are offered ad hoc to schools picking up the program at different times in the year, or when teachers cannot attend any scheduled workshop.

### **Sponsor the Eco-Schools Accreditation Process**

Eco-Schools who have completed the 7 Step process for 3 Themes can apply for a Green Flag. This is an international accreditation that has recognised and rewarded young people's environmental actions for over 25 years.

If Eco-Schools can only cover one or two Themes in a school year, they can apply for a Bronze or Silver Eco-Schools Award respectively, and work their way up to a Green Flag over two or three years.

An Eco-Schools Green Flag is the perfect way to acknowledge, reward and celebrate the ecological achievements of young people. It clearly demonstrates that their hard work is appreciated and it provides them with the confidence and motivation to continue actively engaging with environmental issues now and throughout their lifetimes. It creates the next generation of innovative, inspirational environmentalists and tells local communities that a school is forward-thinking and actively engaged in protecting our planet.

Submissions may be judged in an online format, or in person for a Green Flag application if this is financially feasible.

#### Competition

The Young Reporters for the Environment (YRE) is a program designed to empower young people to take a stand on environmental issues they feel strongly about and give them a platform to express these issues through the media of writing, photography or video.

The program offers enthusiastic young people a chance to have their voices heard through high-quality journalistic work. The ultimate goal of these Young Reporters is to identify environmental injustices, highlight solutions and involve the appropriate authorities to address the environmental issues.

YRE is designed for students aged 11 – 25 years.

Students are asked to pick an environmental topic relating to litter, waste or environmental pollution, investigate it, and then report on it using one of three categories: writing, photography or film.

They are also required to plan an environmental campaign or community action day where students will share their ideas and projects to raise awareness of an environmental issue within the wider school and community.

YRE is a FEE program, and is open to all. We encourage Eco-Schools to participate but the program is also open to students from schools that are not Eco-Schools members.
